

7th piece for 12 cellos

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Players make their own score.

on each beat, each player has a 1/2 chance of playing or resting

if playing, a randomly chosen whole-step glissando lasting 2 beats
(negating any play/rest probability on the second beat of the glissando)
within the piece's one-octave range.

sample below

glissando through the entire 2 beats (do not linger on the beginning or end pitch)

Play with a soft and healthy tone at tempo ca. 50 bpm.

Play for as long as desired.
