The score is created by the players.

The score consists of a series of chords in which each player has a unique note from the 12 lowest pitches on the second string not including the open string.

In each chord the pitches are randomly distributed amongst the 12 players.

Players begin together and spend 8 seconds glissing from their first note to their second note and sustaining the arrival pitch for 2 seconds, all on one bow.

At the unison change of bow, each player glisses over 8 seconds to their next pitch, sustaining it for 2 seconds upon arrival.

This continues for as long as desired.

Play with a soft but not timid sound.
