

5th piano duo

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Sempre pianissimo e dolce.

The tempo is as follows:

-The 16th rest is half a second in duration.

-The measure as a whole is 10 or 11 seconds in duration, indicated for each measure.

Performers can make their own score.

Each measure consists of 1 chord for each piano within the 1-octave range C4 - B4.

The pitches of the chords are randomly decided:

6 pitches are randomly chosen.

They may not be unique, allowing for chords of fewer than 6 pitches.

Which piano plays first is randomly decided.

Whether each measure is 10 or 11 seconds long is randomly decided.

Play for as long as desired.

A sample score is below.
