

for two of the same bowed string instrument

Both players play long slow full bows on the wood edge of the body of the instrument.
All bows are very slow.

Players create their own parts.
Each part consists of a list of randomly chosen numbers between 55 and 95.

One player starts bowing the edge of their instrument (very slowly).

The second player notes the first number in their score,
waits until player one has completed the corresponding percentage of their bow
(if the score number is 78, player two waits until player one has completed 78% of their bow)
and then player two begins bowing the edge of their instrument (very slowly).

When player one reaches the end of their bow, they stop playing.
Player one then waits until player two has completed a certain percentage of their bow
corresponding to the next number in player one's part
and then player one again begins bowing.

Repeat for as long as desired.
