On a computer are listed the 193 1/8-tone pitches between the open C2 and C6 (inclusive).

The cellists take turns playing a pitch that is listed on the screen.

Softly

with duration of 2 seconds

cellos alternating with no overlap or break

With each pitch played, the computer (via max patch) will remove the name of the note nearest in pitch to the note being played.

Players should try their best to play exactly an available note, even though the computer will register the available note nearest in pitch regardless of distance.

The piece is done after 193 pitches have been played.
