

for piano and string sextet
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Players create their own score.

A series of phrases.

Each phrase is between 40 and 60 seconds long (randomly decided).

All pitches occur in the range G#3 - G4.

Each phrase starts with the string players
beginning together on a randomly chosen note within the piece range.

After two seconds, the piano enters on a randomly-chosen pitch (in the piece range).

For the remaining duration of the phrase,
each string player moves their pitch towards the piano pitch,
one half-step at a time,
each pitch lasting for a duration of 2 - 30 seconds
(randomly chosen, with a specificity of 1/10 seconds,
played to the best of the player's ability).

If a string player reaches the piano pitch,
they sustain that pitch until the end of the phrase.

Always a soft, gentle sound, though the piano notes can have some weight.

A several-second pause between each phrase.

Play as many phrases as desired.
