for piano 8-hands Erik Carlson 2017

Players generate their own score. Each player covers an 22-note range of the piano.

Every 20 seconds,

each note on the piano is played once and only once. The score should indicate the time point of the beginning of each note to within 0.1 seconds. Each note is sustained for 3 seconds.

Play softly and gently.

In each 20-second section of the piece, the location of each note within the section should change up to 0.5 seconds in either direction (between -0.5 and 0.5 second change) from what it was in the previous section, (decided randomly) and making sure as the beginning of each note stays within the 20-second section.

Play for as long as desired.
