

fifth piece for solo bowed string instrument  
Erik Carlson  
2017

A series of gestures,  
one gesture per bow,  
always legato  
(a single long line).

The piece is played on a single string  
and a single left hand finger moving along the string.  
The string is marked by 100 imaginary locations,  
1 is the lowest fingered pitch just above open string,  
100 is the pitch at top of the fingerboard.

The player creates their own score.

Begin the piece at location 50.

Each bow lasts for a duration  
randomly determined  
between 6 and 16 beats  
at tempo 120 bpm.  
(Tempo can be subtly flexible throughout the piece.)

On each bow,  
the left hand will either move or not move  
(randomly determined - 1/2 chance of each.)  
If moving, a destination location number is randomly selected.  
Glissando for the full duration of the bow to the new location.

Softly.  
Dolce.  
Play for as long as desired.
