

sixth piece for string orchestra
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All players play notes in rhythmic unison at around tempo 120 bpm.

Players create their own parts. The rhythm is unchanging quarter-notes. The pitch is determined randomly.

There are N players. On each note, the probability that an individual player will play pitch $G\#3$ is $1/N$. Otherwise they play $A\#3$.

The dynamic is very soft.
Play for as long as desired.
